What Preschool students will learn in August:

Science Experiments this month: Leak Proof Bag Experiment- This experiment explores polymers. A polymer is a long flexible chain of molecules. Plastic bags are made of polymers. We are going to fill a bag halfway with water and stick sharpened pencils straight through the bag to the other side, essentially separating polymer chains without breaking them. The long chains of molecules then squeeze in tight around the surface of the pencil preventing any sort of leak.



Engineering Project this month: We are going to build a bubble machine using Styrofoam blocks, a Styrofoam wheel and pipe cleaners.

Math lessons this month: Shape Patterns- This month preschoolers will explore shape patterns.



What Toddlers will learn in August:

Science Experiments this month: Rainbow Jar Experiment- We are going to fill a jar with liquids of different densities. The liquids with higher densities weigh more than the liquids that are less dense. The less dense liquids will sit on top of the denser liquids.

Engineering Project this month: The older toddlers will build towers using marshmallows and toothpicks.

Literacy: The toddlers will begin to identify their own names!





What Infants and Young Toddlers will learn in August:

Infants: The Musician - Infants will use musical tunes to help learn their different body parts and what each part does.



Young Toddlers: The Weather - We will be talking about various forms of weather. We are going to make binoculars from toilet paper rolls to observe the sky.



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
